Description: Map on paper, pasted to canvas. Edges of canvas folded over and glued. Information penned in brown ink. Mapping done in ink with use of blue watercolour along south side of the Ottawa River bank indicating waterline. Shoreline indicated as ragged and undulating. Lot lines are evenly spaced and ruled running north-south about four inches. The features of the north side of river are not shown. The features of the lands south of the lots are not identified. There is paper with “No. 9” in bold black ink pasted onto the map, in the central river (?).

“Plan of Part of the South Side of the Ottawa (or Grand River) containing the Front of Mons^f De Longueils Seigneurie surveyed by J^{os} Papineau and the Front of the Township of Hawkesbury surveyed by Pat^k McNiff with the Proprietor Names inserted in the Lots. Scale 40 Chain in an Inch.”
